Maritime Safety

Annual Safety Inspection

Areas covered are:

Annual inspections of Bahamas registered ships in accordance with the procedures laid down in the latest Guidelines for Inspectors.

Repeated inspections in cases where the original inspection has been proved unsatisfactory.

Investigation of marine casualties as directed by the BMA in accordance with the procedures laid down in the latest Guidelines for Inspectors.

Participation at and/or inspection of any Bahamas Registered ship as directed by the BMA.

Issuing and endorsing certificates of satisfactory inspection and preparation of reports upon completion of inspections in accordance with the latest Guidelines for Inspectors.

Attending a vessel to witness carving and marking then endorse certificates on change of ownership and name in accordance with BMA instructions.

Necessary administrative work.
